



IBR New Kitten Supply List

Travel Carrier

Should be big enough for them to stand up and turn around. Hard plastic carriers are safest.

Kitten Kibble

Most of our kittens are on **Purina One Healthy Kitten**. They should stay on this for at least a few weeks before you transition them to a different kitten food.

Bowls

Heavy ceramic are nice to avoid tipping over.

Scratcher/ Tree/ Post

A healthy way to let them use their claws without damaging furniture.

Toys

jingle Balls, crinkle balls, springs, kicker toys, wand toys, interactive toys

Bed

They love the fluffy donut style beds for biscuit making.

Litter Box + Scoop

A high sided plastic litter box or two.

Litter

Most kittens are using clumping clay litter. Some may use newspaper pellets or wheat scoop.

Collar (optional)

Make sure it is a quick release collar for safety.

Supplements (optional)

Probiotics (Fortiflora/proviable) & Lysine
